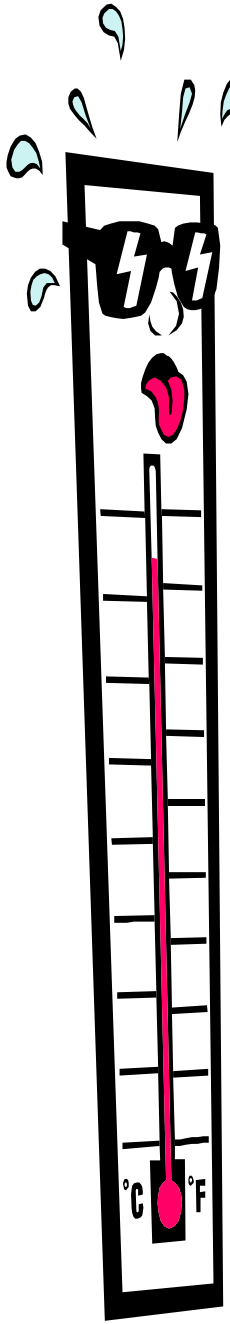


# HOT, HOT, HOT!
